The Hearthstone association dues for this year will be \$183.00 Money collected from every residence goes toward cutting grass, snow plowing, grass fertilizing, tree fertilizing, electricity for walkway lights, dead tree removal, and other general costs associated with keeping our neighborhood looking great. 2022 and 2023 also had large capital improvement projects arise, which, along with contractor inflation, made it necessary to raise the annual dues once again.

Creek widening and rerouting of the approach to Hunters Knoll culvert will improve drainage. The north end drainage convergence of Summerset Place and Victoria Woods Place will have obstruction removal and grading in 2023. Also, the hearth bricks of our entrance façade will require tuck-pointing, which has not been done in the 30-plus years since its construction.

Be aware that dues raises do not occur frivolously. The Board spends considerable time in researching the lowest costs for services, and debating both the amount and necessity of any increases. No one likes to have dues increased; this includes the Board members themselves. We encourage anyone who has questions or concerns to attend our board meetings. Come see the volunteer contributions made by board members toward the upkeep and improvement of our neighborhood.
